


Dear friends and colleagues


Some final remarks before your arrival:

- Please respect the schedule. We will be very rigorous on time management and the sessions will begin at the time announced, regardless of the people present
- You will need to register yourself on arrival at the secretariat. You will be given the SIEBM kit, including your badge. Please use it all time. The registration period will begin at 8 o'clock in the morning
- A generic presence certificate will be included in the kit. If you need a more detailed one, please e-mail us after the symposium and digital version only will be made and sent to you
- We will also be very strict in the time allocated for each oral presentation. You will have 12 minutes and 3 minutes for questions. Please respect this time. As a rule of thumb, if your presentation has more than 13 slides, it is probably too big for the time available.
- During the Symposium, all participants will have a free pass to the TUB network of bus. You need only to show the XX SIEBM badge that will be given to you at the registration desk on arrival
- All the posters will be hanged at the end of the first day, after the plenary session number 2
- All oral presentation MUST be provided at the secretariat till the end of the day before the schedule date (exception: oral presentations of the first day, that MUST be provided during the morning, preferably during the registration). Please take a ppt and a pdf version of your presentation.
- All participants that are illegible to the Luis de Camões prize must send us the information required by the regulation (please see the website and use the email info@20thsiebm.org)
- At the end of the first day, a welcome reception will take place at the city center. The reception is completely informal and includes local snacks, beverages and a taste of local wine. You will need to go from the University to the Nogueira da Silva Museum by your own. It is not far and you will have plenty of time to reach the place (by BUS or even on foot, if you want; see map 1 for directions)
- At the end of the second day, the City Hall has offered us a guided tour through the historic center of Braga. Transportation to the center by Bus will be provided to all.
- On Wednesday, we will have the SIEBM dinner. If you did not register for the dinner and wish to participate, please tell the secretariat on arrival (you will need to pay 50€, as the price of the dinner was not included in your registration).
- For those of you that will arrive by car, access to the Campus will be provided. You must identify yourself at the security entrance (please see map) with the badge of the XX SIEBM. Pay attention that classes begin on 9 September and the parking places are limited. We advise you to arrive early to the Campus. You may park your cars in the green parks (see map 2)
